

YOUR MEMBER HANDBOOK HAS BEEN CHANGED TO INCLUDE MORE SERVICES

Infertility Services

If you are unable to get pregnant, MetroPlus Health Plan covers services that may help.

Starting **October 1, 2019**, MetroPlus Health Plan will cover some drugs for infertility. This benefit will be limited to coverage for 3 cycles of treatment per lifetime.

MetroPlus Health Plan will also cover services related to prescribing and monitoring the use of such drugs. The infertility benefit includes:

- Office visits
- X-ray of the uterus and fallopian tubes
- Pelvic ultrasound
- Blood testing

Eligibility

You may be eligible for infertility services if you meet the following criteria:

- You are 21-34 years old and are unable to get pregnant after 12 months of regular, unprotected sex.
- You are 35-44 years old and are unable to get pregnant after 6 months of regular, unprotected sex.
